

TMN's Indonesia Manta Migration study will investigate the movements of mantas as they leave the Alor Islands in Indonesia which is located near the Komodo National Reserve. This grant will make possible the tagging of manta rays in an area of the world where they are most threatened.

tracking studies in the Maldives. Working

other mantas to be monitored on an ongoing
