


Little Bay Marine Park Dive and Snorkel Trail

Be a responsible diver and snorkeller

- Do not remove plants or animals from the rocks or from their homes.
- Take care not to kick sealife with fins or stand on coral or other delicate sealife.
- Observe animals where they live and don't take anything away with you.
- Do not anchor your boat - always use the mooring buoys.
- Be aware of the boats on the water.
- Do not dive or snorkel alone.
- Do not dive or snorkel during rough or stormy conditions.
